



General Terms and Conditions for Participation

CALL FOR IDEAS INTERGEO 2023

1. Companies/organizations respectively speakers are invited to use the CALL FOR IDEAS process to submit applications to give presentations at INTERGEO 2023 on one of the topics in the official list of topics.
2. A lecture takes approx. 15 to max. 30 minutes. Exact details will follow after the selection of the lecture or after finalizing the programme.
3. The evaluation of the submitted presentations will be done by the organizer. Each applicant will be informed via e-mail regarding if his/her presentation has been accepted for programme.
4. Once a proposed presentation has been accepted, it is not possible for the speaker to retrospectively make substantive changes to the presentation content. Minor updates are possible (via e-mail to christina.gunesch@hinte-expo.com).
5. Each lecture is charged with a fee of 990,00 € plus VAT for exhibitors and 1.290,00 € plus VAT for non-exhibitors
6. All presentations will be recorded and digitally streamed during the event. After the event all participants will get access for the media library for a limited period. The speakers give their consent.
7. The speakers agree that their personal data may be stored and processed within the framework of the organization and implementation of the programs in accordance with the legal provisions and to the extent necessary. This means that HINTE Expo & Conference GmbH may contact the speaker/participant about the course of the program planning and in the event of queries regarding content.
8. The speakers agree to the use and publication of information submitted on the lecture and speakers (lecture title, abstract on the lecture, details on the speaker, biography and portrait photo of the speaker) on the Internet and in printed form for the purpose of press and public relations work (in particular for advertising and communication of the event). The data will not be passed on to third parties.
9. The speakers agree that they may be photographed and/or filmed at the event and that these pictures/videos may be stored, used and published in reports on the event, both in printed form and, in particular, online in the media library as well as in networks accessible worldwide (the internet) and in so-called social networks (e.g. Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, Instagram).
